Filberg Gift Shop Annual Report for 2022

We are happy to report that the Gift Shop increased both revenue and visitors in 2022 and welcomed a steady flow of high-quality donations from generous members of our community.

Our hybrid model of providing Lodge history to our visitors while also offering a unique shopping experience of vintage treasures has proven to be very successful.

The Gift Shop is open every Saturday and Sunday from 11 am to 4 pm. We operated three days per week during July and August and again for five weeks in November and December as part of Christmas in the Park.

Interest in becoming a volunteer at the Gift Shop continues to grow. We currently have a team of 40 volunteers who in 2022 collectively provided 3,900 volunteer hours exclusively to the Gift Shop. Our volunteers are engaged in a myriad of tasks: donation collection, intake, cleaning and sorting; changing displays; polishing silver; research and pricing; managing the shop, cashier duties, weekly treasurer audit; volunteer scheduling; washing and pressing vintage linens and always acting as ambassadors for the Filberg Lodge and Park.
